

The Major Cities of Jesus' Life: **History, Events, Significance**

Glenn Miller will be offering a free, in-depth look at the **historical and geographical background** of the cities of Jesus' childhood and ministry, during the months of Sept/Oct/Nov. The class will meet 6 times, on Tuesday nights at the home of Glenn's parents—Angie and Tollie Miller. The basic format is lecture (previous attendees call it 'firehose style'—smile), with detailed maps, charts, and syllabus.

All the scriptural text and handouts will be in a 3-ring binder/syllabus **provided for attendees for you to keep and take notes in** (so you need to tell us ahead of time to make you one! And you need to remember to bring yours each week!).
